The Chair's Message

As the newly-elected (March 2019) Chair of the ASEE North Central Section (NCS), greetings from Kalamazoo, Michigan, and I hope you all have had a fine fall semester! I'd like to share with you some updates and news of upcoming NCS and ASEE events.

Elections: The results of the 2019 elections for ASEE NCS Board positions were announced at last March's ASEE North Central Section conference in Grand Rapids. I was elected Chair through 2021; David Sawyers (Ohio Northern University) and Greg Bucks (University of Cincinnati) were elected as directors for two-year terms; and Nicholas Baine (Grand Valley State University) was re-elected as section Vice Chair through 2020.

Officer Appointments: Following my election as Chair, we needed a new Campus Representative Coordinator. Who better than Craig Gunn of Michigan State University, who'd managed that position before me so effectively for many years? I'm very pleased that he accepted this responsibility again. We welcome all our new Executive Board members, and we look forward to the continued successful operation from this close-knit team. Spring Conference: The Spring 2020 NCS conference will be at West Virginia University, March 27-28, 2020. Robin Hensel will lead the conference, and the website is: https://www.statler.wvu.edu/asee-ncs-2020. As shared earlier, the abstract deadline is Friday, Dec. 20, so please get those in ASAP. Our regional NCS conferences are lively and interesting events, averaging 120 attendees each year and 60 to 70 peer-reviewed papers from faculty and undergraduate and graduate students. Student posters are also invited. This is a great opportunity for you to present your scholarship and teaching as well as a chance for your students to present their work in a professional setting. We work hard to keep registration and other costs affordable, and we hope you will join us in beautiful Morgantown in March!

Future Section Conferences: At September's NCS Executive Board meeting in Toledo (and thanks to Toledo and Carmen Cioc for their continued support of this geographically-central meeting spot!), sites for upcoming regional NCS conferences were decided. The 2021 Spring conference will be at the University of Toledo, and the 2022 NCS Spring conference will be at University of Pittsburgh.

ASEE National Conference: The 2020 ASEE National Conference will be in Montreal this year, June 21-24. Andrew Kline of our section will complete his two years as Zone II Chair. We hope to see many of you there this June!

Awards: It was recently announced that our section's **Best Paper** from spring 2019 won the Zone II competition. Congratulations to Ron Averill, Sara Roccabianca, and Geoffrey Recktenwald of Michigan

State University! The best zone papers will be presented at the 2020 National ASEE Conference in Montreal, and a national winner will be selected. Also, nominations for the 2019 ASEE NCS *Outstanding Teaching Award* are now open; deadline for submissions is January 15, 2020. All nominations must be submitted on-line through the ASEE National website: https://www.asee.org/

Deadline for nominating is January 15, 2020, and the deadline cannot be extended.

The Award: The award consists of a certificate, prepared by ASEE National Headquarters, and a \$750 honorarium, presented by the North Central Section. Presentations are made at the spring conference with notation in the ASEE Annual Awards Banquet Program. Note: Travel to the conference is not included in the award.

Qualifications: Candidates may be teachers of any subject included in an ABET/CEAB accredited engineering or engineering technology curriculum. In addition to technical courses, subjects may include the humanities and social studies, mathematics and science.
